## Conservation Rules

Fish Care is a main goal at the venue given it is a formally registered Biodiversity offset area. At any given time, an angler could hook a trophy fish at this pristine venue, and it is for this reason that the following conservation rules must be adhered to during the Championship:

- All fish caught must be handle with extreme care. The unhooking cradles will be provided at each peg and must be used for fish larger than 3Kg.
- The minimum line diameter allowed is 0.25mm.
- Braided line may not be used for the main line or leaders. No braid rigs or braid hook lines may be used except the hair line may be made of braid.
- No swimming is allowed at the venue.
- Landing nets with knots is not allowed. Each angler must always have a specimen landing net of a minimum ring size of 700mm wide on the peg. (The specimen landing nets can be rented or purchased at the shop on the venue).
- All Carp bigger than 5kg must be kept in carp sacks until the weigh-in, all carps over 5kg must be placed in a carp sack and the fish must be weighed as quick as possible by requesting the official.

The carp sacks can be rented or purchased at the shop on the venue

- Any trophy fish over 10kg or Tilapia (Kurper) over 2kg are to be weighed as soon as possible after it was caught. The fish must be placed in a carp sack until the official arrives and it must be returned in to dam as soon as possible after the weigh-in process.
