BĘDZIN- BASIC INFORMATION REGARDING THE CITY

Będzin is a city in the north-eastern part of the Silesian Voivodeship, located along the Czarna Przemsza River, in the Silesian Upland. It is one of the oldest cities in the Silesian Voivodeship. It is a commercial, economic, administrative, cultural and educational center of the entire region. Currently, about 50,000 people live in Będzin on an area of 37 km².

Będzin is a city where everyone will find many attractions for themselves. Tourists can follow in the footsteps of a great history, nature lovers can pursue their passions in the bosom of nature, and enthusiasts of active recreation will easily find their way both in the city and in its immediate vicinity.

The most important monuments in Będzin include, among others:

- a medieval castle located on a hill above the Czarna Przemsza River
- Mieroszewski Palace
- an amazing museum of the Będzin underground
- the Holy Trinity Church, the Church of St. Dorota from the 17th century located on the highest hill in the city

Będzin is not only a place of extraordinary historical value, it is also an interesting place to relax for active people who love sports and hiking. Special Family Activity Zones, a water playground, a skate park, and a city beach have been created in the city. The boulevards on the Czarna Przemsza have become a popular place for walks - a zone of recreation and interesting city events. An important element of the revitalization of the boulevards is the modern Będzin Arena - a place where volleyball matches of the MKS Będzin team, boxing fights and other interesting cultural and sports events are held.

Będzin, a city with a 679-year history, attracts tourists with unique monuments, while offering residents extraordinary opportunities to actively spend their free time.

CZARNA PRZEMSA RIVER

The competition will take place on the Czarna Przemsza River near Będzin and Przeczyce. The fishing ground is located from the Przeczyce reservoir dam to the mouth of the Pogorianka stream in Będzin and is approximately 17 km long, including approximately 8 km designated for the competition. The width of the river is from 10 to 20 m, depth from 50 cm to 1.5 meters.

Species present: Trout (*Salmo trutta* m. *fario*, *Oncorhynchus mykiss*), whose weight ranges from 150 grams to about 1000 grams. For the competition, the river will be stocked with brown trout weighing about 150-350 grams.

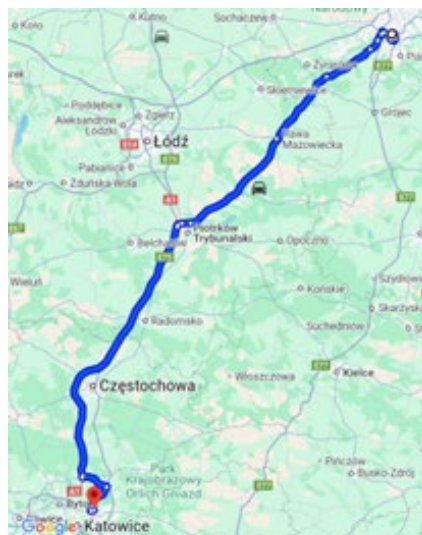


LOCATION

Będzin is located in the Dąbrowa Basin, which is part of the Silesian Dąbrowa Metropolis in south-central Poland.

Location and access from airports:

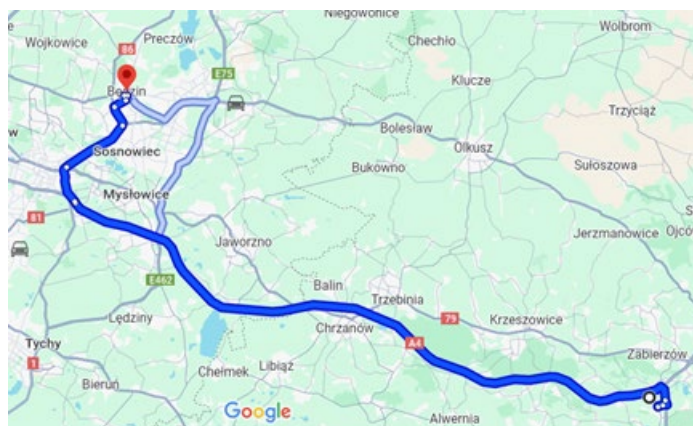
Warsaw (WAW, WMI) – 290 km

REGISTRATION FEES

FIPSeD fee - €200.00

Team fee - €1,300.00

The registration fee includes: 8 tickets for the gala dinner, 5 fishing licenses, insurance and possible small souvenir gadgets. The fee for each additional person for the gala dinner is - €60

During the registration for the championships, the Federations, in addition to the official members of the Delegation, will also be able to register additional people who will be considered as belonging to the Delegation itself. The costs of accommodation and meals will be covered by these additional people.

The registration fee of €1,500 (€1,300.00 + €200) and the fee for the gala dinner for additional people must be paid into the bank account of the Organizer below. Each team is obliged to deliver the anthem and the flag to the Organizer.



COST FOR EXTRA MEDAL

The Federations, in addition to the medals devoted to the official members of the Delegation, will be allowed to ask for extra medals (up to a maximum of 3 per team), upon payment of a contribution of € 25 per extra medal, which will also include the diploma. The fees for extra medals shall be paid to F.I.P.S.e.d. In no case and for no reason extra medals in a number higher than that provided by these Rules may be requested from F.I.P.S.e.d.

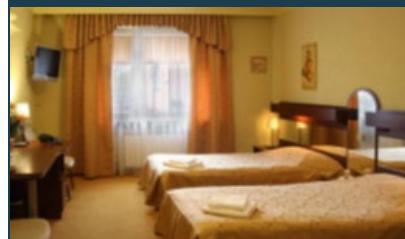

ANTI-DOPING INFORMATION

Athletes participating in the World Championship, with the registration, implicitly accept all WADA anti-doping rules. Athletes whose illness or condition requires treatment with a prohibited substance or method must apply to CIPS for a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) following the CIPS strict TUE application process. He/she shall then use the application form, which can be downloaded from the ITA website: <https://ita.sport/resource/international-testing-agency-therapeutic-use-exemption-tue-application-form/>

The TUE request has to be sent to the following address: tue@ita.sport
Athletes must therefore consult the Prohibited List https://www.wada-ama.org/sites/default/files/2023-09/2024list_en_final_22_september_2023.pdf

If the TUE is granted, the athlete will then be permitted to use the medication during the period of validity of the TUE without committing an Anti-Doping Rules Violation (ADRV).

Regardless of whether a TUE has been granted or not, athletes should always declare on the doping control forms filled out during sample collection any medications and supplements taken within the seven days prior to sample collection, and any blood transfusions in the three months prior for blood samples.

If a TUE has already been granted by a NADO or by a RADO, the Athlete in question does not have to apply for any additional CIPS TUE, as CIPS recognizes all TUE granted by NADOs and RADOs.
